## TELANGANA INDUSTRIAL HEALTH CLINIC - Mapping the road to recovery

### CURRENT SCENARIO AND NEED

- 69120 MSE units in Telangana provide employment to 7.82 lakh people.
- As of 2017, a total of 8618 firms have been

designated as sick units by the SLBC. The Telangana Industrial Health Clinic has been set up to bridge the gap between MSEs and business facilitators. It has also received license to function as an NBFC by RBI in January 2018 and was officially launched on April 2nd 2018. **PROCESS MECHANISM OF TIHCL** TIHCL will offer support to MSEs as part of a three-pronged-strategy:

- Margin amount upto 20% of composite loans.
- Techno-economic valuation of MSE firms.
- Equity capital infusion, support for IPOs.

### FOCUS AREAS FOR TIHCL IN PHASE 1

TIHCL will primarily focus on leather, food Processing, Agro Industry, Tool Room and Machinery Industry through a cluster driven approach.

### SUCCESS STORIES OF THE CLINIC

- One entrepreneur was rescued from SARFAESI Act proceedings by TIHCL which facilitated fast-track payment of Rs 23 lakhs that was to be received by the firm.
- Another small printing firm was also rescued by TIHCL through review of their historical records and coordinating with the bank which had provided the loan.
- 25 entrepreneurs from Sirsilla Textile Park have been rescued from financial collapse and been provided with revival packages.

The We-Hub incubator, launched on 8th March 2018 aims to provide an eco-system for women entrepreneurs through wide range of services including legal support for acquisition of patents, mentorship, bridge between entrepreneurs and investors, government support systems etc. Special focus is on smaller firms wherein support can be provided for incorporation, business development and availing loans. A partnership system will be established with T-Hub, T-Works, T-Fibre and TASK so that entrepreneurs can have end to end support services. A direct

linkage is fostered with the government which can further aid entrepreneurs in receiving support in terms of compliance, incentives and customers. It is funded with a corpus of Rs. 15 crores and will also be backed with funds from the Atal Innovation Programme of NITI Aayog.

### DELAYED PAYMENT PORTAL

Supplier MSE unit can submit online application if payment is delayed by indenting agency. It will be reviewed by the MSE facilitation council and 15 days grace period will be given to the buyer. 1200 out of 5000 cases filed have been resolved. ## DISTRICT INDUSTRY CENTRES - PROGRESS REPORT

### KUMARAMBHEEM ASIFABAD

**PROFILE** - As one of the border districts of Telangana, Kumarambheem Asifabad is richly endowed with resources with logistic support provided by a state highway in addition to the local road network. Due to the above, it has the capacity to become a food processing hub for the entire southern region of India.

**PRESENT SCENARIO** - Currently, there are 484 industrial connections in the district with additions as a result of TS-iPASS portal.

**INITIATIVES** - DIC organized training sessions for DRDO staff in order to raise awareness of state government schemes at the grassroots level. Two Mudra Melas were conducted to facilitate credit provision to MSEs in the district. A proposal to set up an industrial park on 200 acres is under study by TSIIC and the district officials.

### RANGAREDDY

**PROFILE** - Rangareddy is in close proximity to the state capital Hyderabad and is home to the reputed international airport of Telangana state. There is a presence of 4618 MSE units in this district alone with a total investment of Rs. 2556.84 crores. Rangareddy is also abundant in various mineral resources.

**PRESENT SCENARIO** - 1076 clearances have been issued for 549 enterprises as of April 2018 through TS-iPASS portal.

**INITIATIVES** - Development of a 14000 acre pharma city with an investment potential of Rs 1 lakh crores is in progress in the district. Proposal of plastic park, fiber cluster and IT park is under way. Despite being a landlocked district, a proposal for establishment of container freight facilities is under evaluation.
