Vide reference cited, of the Member Secretary, AICTE, New Delhi, it is to inform that, Government Polytechnics established under the MHRD Scheme operating from temporary location have to be shifted to permanent location within a period of two years of the grant of approval by AICTE and as per the direction of MHRD, AICTE has to visit these establishments for assessing the readiness in terms of classrooms/labs/equipments etc., within two years for considering to grant approval.

Further, the AICTE records available in Approval Bureau Five institutes (as detailed below) of have not yet shifted to permanent location.
