The Government Polytechnics in the state have physically reopened to students on 01.02.2021 after the lockdown imposed due to COVID-16 pandemic. In order to make the ambience of Polytechnics lively and promote greenery in the Polytechnic campuses, the commissioner of Technical Education, Telangana, Hyderabad, instructs all the Government Polytechnics to carry out Mass plantation drives in their respective Polytechnic Campuses.

‘Telanganaku Haritha Haaram’ is the flagship programme of the Government of Telangana. It conceives to increase the tree cover of the Telangana State from 25.16% to a minimum of 33% of its total Geography. The main goal of this programme is to restore the ecological balance, conserve biodiversity and protect soil and its nutrients. For this purpose, massive plantation programmes have been underway since the past six years.

All the Principals of Government Polytechnics in Telangana State are hereby instructed to carry out Mass Plantation drives on 17.02.2021 by planting saplings at their respective Polytechnics under **“Telanganaku Haritha Haaram”**. Further, a detailed report on the saplings planted, their number, location and photographs have to be submitted to O/o CTE by e-mail to adkctets@gmail.com without fail.
