This has reference to the letter cited, wherein the UGC has shared UGC
(Credit framework for online Learning course through Study webs of Active
Learning for Young inspiring minds) Regulations, 2021, enabling provision for an
Institution to allow up to 40% of the total courses being offered in a particular
program in a semester through the online learning courses offered through the
SWAYAM platform (www.swayam.gov.in).

As stated in the D.O. letter cited, in the current scenario of the second
wave of the COVID-19, Universities & Colleges have been requested to make
optimum use of the SWAYAM online platform for the benefit of the
students/learners. The list of 83 UG & 40 PG MOOCs course, that are ready to
be offered on the SWAYAM platform in July-October Semester 2021 and may
also be seen at <https://swayam.gov.in/CEC>. Further, looking at the current
COVID-19 pandemic scenario, the Universities and Colleges have been requested
to popularize these SWAYAM courses amongst students and faculty through
websites and various social media handles.

Further, the AICTE, New Delhi, has issued AICTE (Open and distance
learning Education and online Education, Guidelines, 2021, vide Ref.2nd cited.

In the circumstances, the Registrars of the Universities concerned are
hereby requested to examine the above and to integrate the SWAYAM courses
into the curriculum and list the courses which can be permitted for the students
for credit transfer and encourage more and more students to enrol in these
courses to ensure uninterrupted teaching learning for students, duly making
suitable academic regulations at University level, under intimation to this office.
