ORDER:

With reference to the above cited, Sri. K.V.Rao, Director & Head, Bureau Of Indian Standards Promotion Activities and Formation of standards clubs Hyderabad has stated that Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), the National Standards Body of the Country is providing learning opportunities to young talents in the field of quality and standardization through mutually beneficial collaboration in the form of Standards Clubs in Technical Education Institutions. Teachers would have an important role in this activity and would serve as beacons of light, guiding and motivating students to channelize their creativity and enhancing their scientific temperament.

Salient Features of BIS Training Program:

1. To familiarize the Mentors with the Activities of BIS, its role in the national quality ecosystem, and to the various features of BIS websites and Portals.
2. To develop an understanding of principles of quality, standardization and the structures of different types of standards.
3. To comprehend the various quality characteristics of products and services and to write standards prescribing requirements and methods of tests.
4. To enable the mentors to fully understand the Operation of Standards Clubs and their own Roles and Responsibilities, along with a training session to gain more focus on the objective.

BIS is arranging a Residential Training programme for Mentors of Standard Clubs in Hyderabad for two days (07th and 08th July, 2022). BIS will make arrangements for the boarding and lodging of the trainee mentor. BIS will reimburse travel expenses from originating station to destination station by train fare of AC 2 Tier or any other mode of travel subject to AC 2 Tier train fare or actual, whichever is less, on the production of original receipt(s) and/or invoice(s). In cases, where the places are not connected by train, then bus fares up to the limit of AC bus to be considered for reimbursement subject to production of bill/ticket.

In this connection, the selected Principals of Government Polytechnics of Telangana State are hereby informed that the SPOCs nominated from each

polytechnic shall be the mentors for the Standards Clubs of BIS in Government Polytechnics.

Further, the selected Principals of Government Polytechnics are hereby directed to relieve the 14 incumbent SPOC's (mentors) in advance so as to enable them to report to the training programme on 07.07.2022 by 08:00 AM at Hotel Aditya Park, Ameerpet, Hyderabad, Telangana.

The above staff members are informed that, this is an "**Optionally Residential Program**". However, accommodation & boarding facilities shall be provided for the mentors from 12:00 P.M. on 06.07.2022 till 09:00 A.M. on 09.07.2022 at Hotel Aditya Park, Aditya Trade Center, Satyam Theatre Road, Ameerpet, Hyderabad, Telangana-500038.

The selected Principals of Government Polytechnics shall intimate this office about relieving of individuals to the training programme.
