Sub: CS - PDS - Adverse news published in Velugu News Paper on dated 20.06.2022 stated that **"PURUUGULA ANNAM THINALEKA AIDU ROJULUGA PASTULU"** - Certain Instructions Issued- Reg.

I invite kind attention to the subject cited, and informed that several adverse news items are publishing in newspapers in respect of using un hygiene MDM rice at educational institutions.

Therefore, the following guidelines are issued to avoid adverse news and to provide hygiene Food to the Students/Inmates:

- 1) At the time of lifting of rice stocks from MLS Points, the representative of institutions has to thoroughly check the quality and quantity at the godown premises itself. If the quality of the stocks are found to be un-satisfactory in infested condition, the representative of the institution is at liberty to reject the consignment for lifting.
- 2) Proper care in maintenance/preservation of the stocks at Schools/Hostels is requested to be maintained. Ensure the storage of food grains in leak proof and highly ventilated rooms to avoid damages to the rice.
- 3) Hygiene should be maintained while cooking, keeping in view of the health of students and inmates and to avoid such types of adverse/ incidents. While cooking the rice hygiene of vassels and ambience are ensured.
- 4) Monthly inspections should be conducted at the Schools and Hostels by the concerned district officials with respect to maintenance of the stocks, to check whether above parameters are being followed or not.
- 5) The indents should be restricted upto the actual requirement duly adjusting the closing balances available at the end of the academic year closure, to avoid damage of the stocks during the holidays.
- 6) Stock balance reports should be forwarded to this department after completion of the March consumption every year.
- 7) Every month the stocks available as balance with the schools have to be checked and quality to be reported in the stock register duly signed by the incharge with the attestation of the school Head Master.

- 8) The incharge should ensure that the balances of the previous month have to be utilized before going for the cooking of new stocks to avoid damage to old stocks due to long storage, gets infestation etc.

The Head of the School Education, ICDS and Welfare Departments are requested to ensure that the above instructions are followed scrupulously.
